

The Cloud Factory Activity Page



Parents, use these suggested activities to encourage discussion with your child about how God created clouds and everything else in nature.

In the beginning God created the sky and the earth. (Genesis 1:1)



Find a comfortable place outside to sit with your child. Look up at the sky. Find clouds that look like animals, shapes or faces. Explain that God made everything we see in the sky. Talk about the good things God provides by making clouds: like shade, rain, and snow.



Help your child create a picture of the sky as he/she thinks it looked on that first day of creation. Use cotton balls and glue to make the clouds. For added fun, encourage them to make one of the clouds look like their favorite animal.



Use ***The Cloud Factory*** DVD to teach your child how clouds are formed, then help your child learn to identify the different types of clouds. Have them play the “Hide and Seek” game to practice or identify different clouds while you go for a walk or drive.
